A study of the cardiovascular, respiratory and lymphatic systems.

Anatomy & Physiology 1 (IAM/TCM/CEU) - Online

Introduction to the structure and function of the body. Study of tissues, organs, skeletal and muscular systems.

Anatomy & Physiology 2 (IAM/TCM/CEU) - Online

Communications and Terminology 1 (IAM/TCM/NHP/CEU) - Online

The use of roots, prefixes, suffixes, plurals and opposites.

(1 credit) No Pre-requisite.

September 28 to November 3

Communications and Terminology 2 (IAM/TCM/NHP/CEU) - Online

Significant focus is placed on the understanding, writing and pronouncing of medical terms, as they relate to Anatomy, Physiology and Pathology. The emphasis is on body systems.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Communication Terminology 1.

Tuesdays 10:35am – 12:30pm, and **Wednesdays** 10:35am – 12:00 noon
November 9 to December 15

Communications and the Healthcare Professional (IAM/TCM/NHP/CEU) - Online

Learn the key characteristics for day-to-day communications with clients and understand the personal and client needs.

(1 credit) No Pre-requisite.

September 29 to December 15

Dermatology and 5 Senses (TCM) - Online

Students learn to differentiate TCM patterns for disorders of the ears, eyes, nose, throat, mouth and skin. Treatment principles, acupuncture point prescription and other methods of treatment are discussed for each TCM pattern.

(1 credit) Pre-requisites: Meridian Theory 1, Diagnosis and Treatments 1, Theory Foundations 1, Point Locations 1-2.

September 30 to December 16

Food Cures (TCM) - Online

This course provides an understanding of nutritional concepts. The ability to communicate effectively with your clients or other healthcare practitioners about basic nutritional elements and considerations, as well as the macro and micro nutrients.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Meridian Theory 1, Theory Foundations 1, Diagnostics & Treatments 1, Point Locations 1-2.

Hydrotherapy for the RMT (IAM/NHP) – In-person

The majority of this course covers hydrotherapy theory with emphasis on practical hydrotherapy applications in both a clinical and self-care context.

Jurisprudence (IAM) - Online

Learn the basics of massage, including draping and positioning. Develop a routine for a general full body massage treatment.

Meridian Theory 1 (TCM) - Online

The course presents an insight into this fascinating system of Chinese medicine, which encompasses the important concept of Yin/Yang to the presence of illness or wellness and the need for balance between Yin & Yang.

(1 credit) No Pre-requisite.

Wednesdays 6:00pm – 8:00pm

September 29 to December 15

Modern Mental Diseases (TCM) - Online

Students learn to differentiate TCM patterns for disorders such withdrawal, mania, irritability, frequent joy, worry, over-thinking, fear, fright, agitation, impaired memory, profuse dreams, insomnia, ADHD, schizophrenia, obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD), bipolar, depression and anxiety. Appropriate acupuncture point combinations for each pattern diagnosis are presented and discussed.

(1 Credit) Pre-requisites: Meridian Theory 1, Theory Foundations 1, Diagnosis & Treatments 1, Point Locations 1-2.

Thursdays 8:05pm – 10:00pm

September 30 to December 16

Myology 2 (IAM) – In-person

An in-depth study of the torso muscles.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Anatomy/Myology 1.

Mondays 1:15 pm – 3:15pm

September 27 to December 13

Myology 2 (TCM) – Online

The study of the muscular system and meridians from a TCM perspective, including the study of the structure, function and diseases of muscle/meridians continue.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Myology 1 (TCM).

Thursdays 6:05pm – 7:50pm

September 30 to December 16

Needling Lab (TCM) – In-person

Students evolve their needling skills via this hands-on course. Students are guided by faculty to needle numerous combinations of acupuncture points.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Anatomy/Physiology 1-4, Pathology 1, Diagnosis and Treatments 1, Meridian Theory 1, Point Locations 1-2, Techniques of Acupuncture 1-2, Theory Foundations 1, Clinical Safety.

September 26 to December 12

Neuroscience 2 (IAM) - Online

An in-depth examination of the sensory division of the nervous system.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Neuroscience 1.

Wednesdays 1:15pm – 3:05pm

September 29 to December 15

Off Site Clinical Practical 3 (IAM) – In-person

Massage therapy treatment is given to people with mental and physical developmental disabilities.

(2 credits) Pre-requisite: Massage Techniques 1-4, Anatomy & Physiology 4.

Thursdays 1:15pm – 4:30pm

September 30 to December 16

Orthopedics (TCM) – In-person

Students learn to differentiate TCM patterns for disorders of the locomotor system including bones, muscles, joints and all related tissues. Acupuncture point combinations for each pattern diagnosis are presented and discussed.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Meridian Theory 1, Diagnosis & Treatments 1, Theory Foundations 1, Point Location 1-2, Techniques of Acupuncture 1-2, Clinical Safety.

Sundays 9:00am – 11:00am

September 26 to December 12

Pain Management and Rehabilitation 1 (TCM) - Online

Students learn to differentiate TCM patterns for pain located in various parts of the body including the heel, foot, leg, and knee. Acupuncture point combinations for each pattern diagnosis, are presented and discussed.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Meridian Theory 1, Diagnosis & Treatments 1, Theory Foundations 1, Point Location 1-2, Techniques of Acupuncture 1-2, Clinical Safety.

Mondays 10:35am – 12:30pm

September 27 to December 13

Pain Management and Rehabilitation 2 (TCM) - Online

Students learn to differentiate TCM patterns for pain located in various parts of the body including the hip, low-back, hand, elbow, shoulder and the neck. Appropriate acupuncture point combinations for each pattern diagnosis are presented and discussed.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Meridian Theory 1, Diagnosis & Treatments 1, Theory Foundations 1, Point Location 1-2, Techniques of Acupuncture 1-2, Clinical Safety.

Pathology 1 (IAM/TCM/NHP/CEU) - Online

Begin the study of the structural effects of disease on body systems and organs at the tissue and cellular level.

(1 credit) No Pre-requisite

Pathology 4 (IAM/TCM) - Online

An in-depth study of muscle-related diseases.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Pathology 1, Anatomy/Physiology 4.

Mondays 8:30am – 10:20am

September 27 to December 13

Pathology 5 (IAM/TCM) - Online

An in-depth study of diseases of the nervous system.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Pathology 1.

Mondays 10:35am – 12:30pm, and **Wednesdays** 8:30am – 10:20am

September 27 to November 3

Pathology 6 (IAM/TCM) - Online

An in-depth study of the digestive tract diseases and conditions.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Pathology 1.

Mondays 10:30am – 12:30pm, and **Wednesdays** 8:30am – 10:20am

November 8 to December 15

Pathophysiology 1 (TCM) - Online

This course provides a brief overview of the etiology and pathogenesis of the conditions listed in Appendix K and L of the Candidate's Guide for the Pan Canadian Examinations from a Biomedicine approach only.

(1 Credit) Prerequisites: Meridian Theory 1, Theory Foundations 1, Diagnostics & Treatments 1, Point Locations 1-2, Anatomy/Physiology 1-4, Pathology 1 and Point Functions 1.

Patient Clinical Studies 1 (TCM) – In-person

Students evolve their diagnosis/treatments skills via instructor-directed case studies.

(3 credit) Pre-requisite: Diagnosis and Treatments 1, Meridian Theory 1, Point Locations 1-2, Theory Foundations 1, Anatomy/Pathology 1-4, Physiology 1, Point Function 1, Clinical Safety and Techniques of Acupuncture 1-2. Students must request approval from the Program Director before enrolling in this course.

Physiology 6 (IAM/TCM) - Online

A deeper study of energy formation in the cell, the nervous system and metabolism.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Physiology 5

Physiology 7 (IAM/TCM) - Online

Students continue to study the finer aspects of the nervous system. This course also takes an in-depth look into the muscular system, including a study of skeletal and smooth muscle; and the cardiovascular system.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Physiology 6.

Point Functions 2 (TCM) - Online

The Point Functions courses examine different functions and uses in TCM point prescriptions to successfully improve patients' health. This second module explores point location, function and combination of the following meridians: Kidney, San Jiao, Pericardium, Gallbladder, Liver, Du & Ren

(1 Credit) Pre-requisites: Meridian Theory 1, Theory Foundations 1, Point Locations 1-2.

Point Functions 3 (TCM) – Online

The study of numerous acupuncture point categories, along with the extra acupuncture points listed in the Pan Canadian Candidate Examination Guide.

(1 Credit) Pre-requisites: Meridian Theory 1, Theory Foundations 1, Point Locations 1- 2.

Thursdays 4:00pm – 5:50pm

September 30 to December 16

Point Locations 1 (TCM) - Online

Students learn the location of approximately half of the body's acupuncture points.

(1 credit) No pre-requisite.

Mondays 6:00pm – 10:00pm - September 27 to November 1

Monday 6:00pm – 8:00pm - November 8

Point Locations 2 (TCM) – Online

Students learn to locate and palpate the acupuncture point for all of the points from the following seven meridians: Kidney, Pericardium, San Jiao, Gallbladder, Liver, Ren (conception) and Du (governing).

(1 Credit) No pre-requisite

Monday 8:00pm – 10:00pm - November 8

Mondays 6:00pm – 10:00pm - November 15 to December 13

Pregnancy Theory & Clinic (IAM) –In-person

This course covers the proper skills and techniques required by a massage therapist to treat pregnant, laboring, postpartum women and their infants.

(1 credits) Pre-requisite: Treatments 1.

Principles of Treatments & Advanced Techniques 5-8 (IAM) – In-person

Learn to treat a variety of chronic conditions using massage therapy.

(4 credits) Pre-requisite: Principles of Treatments/Advanced Techniques 1-4.

Remedial Exercise 1 (IAM) – In-person

The theory and practice of remedial exercise assessment, plan development, implementation and evaluation. Range of motion and stretching is also presented.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Advanced Techniques 1-4 and Myology 1.

Remedial Exercise 3 (IAM) – In-person

Students continue to evolve their knowledge of exercise and stretching.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Remedial Exercise 2.

Research 1 (IAM/TCM/NHP/CEU) – Online

Research 1 is a course which aims to present and discuss the importance of research literacy among health care practitioners. Topics covered include critical thinking, various ways knowledge/intelligence can be acquired, decision making and heuristics that impact decision making, the importance of research in healthcare, the critical evaluation of published articles and papers, and how it applies to professional health practitioners, health research sources, calculating and interpreting basic statistics, and the structure of a research paper and how to approach the development of a research paper.

(1 credit) No pre-requisite.

Research 2 (IAM/TCM) - Online

Students are guided through the creation of their own research paper.

(1 credit) Pre-requisite: Research 1.

Learn the foundation of this 3000-year-old Chinese medicine, including Yin-Yang theory, the 5 elements, Qi, blood and all organ functions.

Treatments 2 (IAM) – In-person

Learn to treat a variety of pathologies and conditions using massage therapy. A hands-on skill development.

TuiNa 1 (TCM/NHP/CEU) – In-person

TuiNa 2 (TCM/NHP/CEU) – In-person

Students learn to complete a full-body treatment, facial massage and self-massage using Tuina. It's principles as a TCM treatment modality are also presented and discussed.

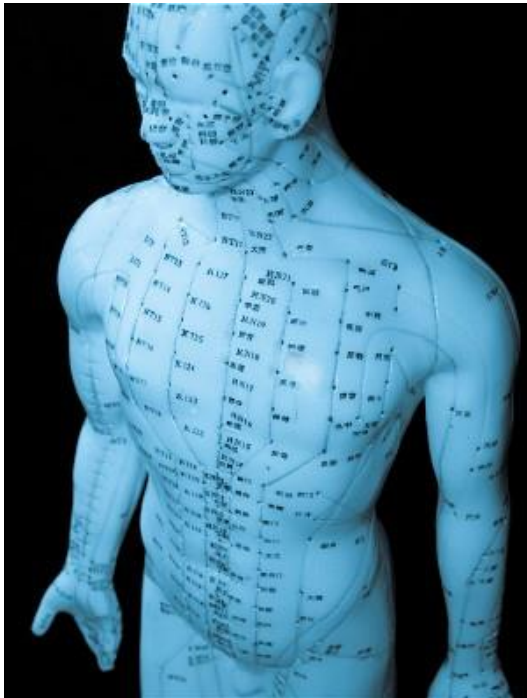
